AN ACT

An Act to add new Section 8516.1 to Chapter 6, Title IX, Government Code of Guam, to provide an immunity from liability for licensors of shelter space.

*Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:*

Section 1. A new Section 8516.1 is hereby added to Chapter 6, Title IX, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 8516.1. No Private Liability. Any person owning or controlling real estate or other premises who voluntarily and without compensation grants a license or privilege, or otherwise permits the designation or use of the whole or any part or parts of such real estate or premises for the purpose of sheltering persons during an actual, impending, mock or practice attack, or natural disaster, shall, together with his successors in interest, if any, not be civilly liable for negligently causing the death of, or injury to, any person on or about such real estate or premises, or loss of, or damage to, the property of such person, arising out of such use."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
