Public Law 7-88 Seventh Guam Legislature (Bill 169) February 12, 1964

AN ACT

An Act to add new Sections 31072 and 31073 to Chapter 1, Title XXXII, Government Code of Guam, relative to enforcement of orders and jurisdiction under the building law.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. A new Section 31072 is hereby added to Chapter 1, Title XXXII, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 31072. Enforcement of Orders. If any person fails to comply with any order that has become final, the Attorney General may apply for the enforcement of the order to the Island Court of Guam. If the Court determines that the order was made and served in accordance with the law and that such person failed to comply therewith, the Court shall enforce obedience to the order by writ of injunction or otherwise to enjoin upon such person compliance with the order."

Section 2. A new Section 31073 is hereby added to Chapter 1, Title XXXII, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 31073. Jurisdiction. The Island Court of Guam shall have jurisdiction over all actions arising from the provisions of this Title."

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
