AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2955 OF THE CIVIL CODE OF GUAN TO PERMIT THE MORTGAGE OF STOCK IN TRADE OF A MERCHANT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 2955 of the Civil Code of Guam is hereby

amended to read as follows:

"Section 2955. What property may be mortgaged.

Chattel mortgages. (1) Mortgages may be made upon all growing crops, including grapes and fruits, and upon any and all kinds of personal property except the following:

- 1. Personal property not capable of manual delivery;
- 2. Articles of wearing apparel and personal adornment.
- (2) Mortgages upon personal property may be termed chattel mortgages.
- Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
