AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER 15 TO TITLE III,  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO  
DELEGATES TO NATIONAL CONVENTIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Chapter 15, Title III, Government Code of Guam, is  
3 hereby enacted to read as follows:

4 "CHAPTER 15

5 Selection of Delegates to National Conventions

6 Section 2800. Recognized political party--national  
7 convention. A recognized political party, affiliated with  
8 a national political party which holds a convention for  
9 the purpose of nominating candidates for President of the  
10 United States shall select delegates and alternates to  
11 such national convention. Such delegates and alternates  
12 from the recognized political party shall be chosen in  
13 the exact number authorized by the rules of such national  
14 political party.

15 Section 2801. Same--selection of delegates.  
16 Delegates and alternates from the recognized political  
17 party to the national convention of such party shall be  
18 selected by secret ballot of such recognized political  
19 party at a meeting called by the Chairman on or before  
20 the first Tuesday of the fourth month of Presidential  
21 election years. The authorized representatives of the  
22 recognized political party who may so participate in  
23 the voting for delegates and alternates to the national  
24 convention shall consist of:

25 (1) All members of the Guam Legislature who are  
26 voters of the recognized territorial political party;

1 (2) All municipal and assistant municipal

2 commissioners who are voters of the recognized territorial  
3 political party;

4 (3) Certain persons chosen by the officers of  
5 such party, selected under Section 2009, from municipi-  
6 palities which do not have commissioners or assistant  
7 commissioners who are voters of that party as follows:  
8 For each municipal commissioner or assistant commissioner  
9 who is not a voter of the recognized political party, the  
10 officers of such party shall designate one voter registered  
11 in such party from such municipality;

12 (4) Certain persons designated from the territory-  
13 at-large by the officers of such party, selected under  
14 Section 2009 of this code, in a number equal to the  
15 difference between the number of voters registered in  
16 such party who are members of the Legislature and the  
17 total number of authorized members of the Legislature;

18 (5) The officers of the recognized political  
19 party selected under Section 2009 of this code;

20 (6) The national committeeman and national committee-  
21 woman of the recognized political party who were selected  
22 at the next previous national convention or, in case no  
23 such selection was made, the persons designated by the  
24 officers of the recognized political party for those  
25 positions."

26 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
