AN ACT MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND PERSONNEL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1964. AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR RETAINING AN INDEPENDENT AUDIT FIRM TO AUDIT ALL FUNDS OF THE GOVERNMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1964.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of \$1,430.00 is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to supplement the appropriation previously made for the operation of the Department of Labor and Personnel for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964.

Section 2. The sum of \$50,000 is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the purpose of conducting a limited mudit of the accounts and financial transactions of all funds of the Government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
