AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$5,000  
TO COMPLETE THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE DRAINAGE  
SYSTEM IN ASAN.

WHEREAS, although the Legislature previously appropriated sufficient funds to complete the construction of a drainage system throughout the Village of Asan, it was necessary in the aftermath of Typhoon Karen, to reappropriate funds for more immediate emergency projects; and

WHEREAS, the completion of the drainage system in Asan is, in the opinion of the Legislature, a matter of great urgency and should be undertaken before the beginning of the rainy season since during the rainy season the residents of the village suffer considerably because of the inadequate drainage; now therefore

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds  
3 in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the Government of Guam  
4 the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) to complete the construction of  
5 a drainage system in the Village of Asan, Municipality of Asan.

6 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
