AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4109 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE CONSTRUCTION BATTALION EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY AGENCY SHALL BECOME PERMANENT EMPLOYEES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4109 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4109. Hourly Rates of Pay. In the event
5 it is desirable to establish hourly rates of pay for tempo-
6 rary, seasonal, intermittent, project, or part-time employ-
7 ment in any class of position in the classified service the
8 Director of Labor and Personnel shall determine such hourly
9 rates by dividing by 2080 the annual pay rates in the range
10 of pay established for the class by or under this chapter.
11 Normally, Step 'A' in the appropriate pay range shall be
12 used in making this calculation, but the Director of Labor
13 and Personnel, however, may, with the prior approval and
14 consent of the Personnel Board, authorize as compensation
15 for such employment, hourly rates based on higher steps in
16 the pay range if recruitment conditions or other circum-
17 stances warrant such action."

18 Section 2. The employment status of those temporary employees
19 of the Public Utility Agency of Guam, and of the Department of Public Works,
20 the latter commonly referred to as the "Construction Battalion", shall be
21 converted as of the effective date of this Act from "temporary" to
22 "permanent", subject to the following conditions:

(a) Initial appointment shall be probationary,
in accord with the Personnel Rules and Regulations;

(b) Such employees shall retain their current
class titles, subject to classification study, following
which compensation shall be adjusted to the first step
of the pay range of the position determined by such
study;

(c) For purposes of calculating leave benefits,
such employees shall be credited with their temporary
service."

Section 3. This Act shall become effective as of July 1, 1964.

Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
