AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11006 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO RENAME THE TUMON JUNIOR-SENIOR
HIGH SCHOOL THE "JOHN F. KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL".

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11006 is hereby added to the Government Code
3 of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 11006. John F. Kennedy High School. The
5 junior-senior high school located in the Municipality of
6 Dededo, and heretofore known as the 'Tumon Junior-Senior
7 High School' is hereby designated the 'John F. Kennedy
8 High School', and, at such ceremony as the director deems
9 appropriate, said high school shall be so officially named."

10 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
