AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11006 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN TO RENAME THE TUNON JUNIOR-SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL THE "JOHN F. KENNEDY HIGH SCHOOL".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1. Section 11006 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11006. John F. Kennedy High School. The junior-senior high school located in the Municipality of Dededo, and heretofore known as the 'Tumon Junior-Senior High School' is hereby designated the 'John F. Kennedy High School', and, at such ceremony as the director deems appropriate, said high school shall be so efficially named." Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
