AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION FUND AND THE LAND RENTALS PAYABLE AFTER JULY 1, 1964.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated, from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the sum of Twenty Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Five and No/100 Dollars (\$20,795.00) for the Workmen's Compensation Fund established by Section 37042, Government Code of Guam.

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated, from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Thirty—Five and No/100 Dollars (\$15,035.00) to supplement prior appropriations for payment of rentals for privately owned land leased by the Government.

Section 3. Appropriations made by this Act shall take effect and be available as of July 1, 1964.
