AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 200 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM PERTAINING TO LEGAL HOLIDAYS OF
THE TERRITORY OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 200 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 200. Holidays. The holidays of this
5 territory are:

- 6 (a) Every Sunday.
7 (b) Christmas Day, December 25.
8 (c) New Year's Day, January 1.
9 (d) Washington's Birthday, February 22.
10 (e) Good Friday.
11 (f) Memorial Day, May 30.
12 (g) Independence Day, July 4.
13 (h) Liberation Day, July 21.
14 (i) Labor Day, first Monday in September.
15 (j) Veterans Day, November 11.
16 (k) Every day on which an election is held
17 throughout Guam.
18 (l) Every day appointed by the President of the
19 United States or the Governor of Guam for a
20 public fast, Thanksgiving day, or holiday."

21 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
