"Section 200. Holidays. The holidays of this

territory are:

(a) Every Sunday.

- (b) Christmas Day, December 25.
- (c) New Year's Day, January 1.
- (d) Washington's Birthday, February 22.
- (e) Good Friday.
- (f) Memorial Day, May 30.
- (g) Independence Day, July 4.
- (h) Liberation Day, July 21.
- (i) Labor Day, first Monday in September.
- (j) Veterans Day, November 11.
- (k) Every day on which an election is held throughout Guam.
- Every day appointed by the President of the United States or the Governor of Guam for a public fast, Thanksgiving day, or holiday."
- Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
