BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 13213.1 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam
to read as follows:

"Section 13213.1. The public road in the Municipality of
Merizo under construction under the Public Works project name
of the Acot-Acho Road is hereby named the "Quinene Road" after
the late Jesus R. Quinene, Congressman from Merizo."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
