AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated, from any available
3 sums in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, for the purposes set forth
4 herein;

5	(a) Construction of Industrial Arts Building

16 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds of the
17 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$105,518 for the operation of
18 the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965.

19 Section 3. The appropriations made by this Act shall be effective
20 immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for
21 which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect
22 and shall be available until expended for the project for which the appropriation
23 is made or until the project is completed.

24 Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
