AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13608 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO RECORDING OF DOCUMENTS
AT THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND MANAGEMENT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 13608 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 13608. Filing of Documents for Records in the
5 Department of Land Management. No document purporting to establish
6 title to land as a result of proceedings under the 'Land Title
7 Registration Act', presented to the Department of Land Management
8 for recording, shall be filed, unless accompanied by a map, plat,
9 sketch or other plane pictorial representation of the lot, parcel
10 or tract of land involved, made within a one year period preceding
11 presentation for filing, or, with regard to land taken in conde-
12 nation proceedings, made within one year preceding the filing of the
13 action for condemnation, and bearing a certification of the following
14 facts:

15 (a) That it was prepared as the basis of a field
16 survey by either (1) a surveyor registered by the Guam
17 Board of Engineering and Architectural Examiners under
18 the Professional Engineers, Architects and Land Surveyors
19 Law, Title XLIII, Government Code of Guam, holding a
20 current certificate of registration issued by the Board
21 covering the period that the map, plat, sketch or other
22 pictorial representation of the land was made, or the
23 field work incident thereto was performed, or (2) a

1 Engineers, Architects and Land Surveyors Law.

2 (b) That it was based upon data obtained from
3 the use of the 'Guam Geodetic Triangulation Net' and,
4 where coordinate values were used, the relationship
5 of such coordinates to the 'Guam Geodetic Triangulation
6 Net' was determined by the use of physically ascertained
7 courses and distances."
