AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 13808.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO RECORDING OF DOCUMENTS AT THE
DEPARTMENT OF LAND MANAGEMENT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 13808.1 is hereby added to the Government Code
3 of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 13808.1. Same: reference to map. No document
5 purporting to affect the transfer of the fee simple ownership
6 of land, presented to the Department of Land Management for
7 recording, shall be filed, unless said document bears on it
8 a reference to a map, plat, sketch or other plane pictorial
9 representation of the lot, parcel or tract of land involved,
10 containing a legal metes and bounds description thereof,
11 prepared by the government of Guam, the Naval Government of
12 Guam, or an authorized surveyor, and previously recorded at
13 the Department of Land Management. If no such map, plat, sketch,
14 or other plane pictorial representation is on record at the
15 Department of Land Management, then no such document shall be
16 filed unless accompanied by a map, plat, sketch or other
17 pictorial representation conforming to the requirements of
18 Section 13808."

19 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
