AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4231 OF CHAPTER 3, TITLE V. GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO EXPENSES OF RETIREMENT FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUANT.

Section 1. Section 4231, of the Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4231. Intent of law. It is the intention of this Chapter that the payment of the required contributions by the government shall be an obligation of the government, and all allowances, annuities, benefits, and administration, custodial and audit fees shall be paid from the fund."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
