Introduced by F. M. Bamba

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 4020 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF  
GUAM TO PERMIT PAYROLL DEDUCTION FROM THE WAGES OF  
THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYEES FOR SMALL BUSINESS  
ADMINISTRATION LOANS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4020 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam  
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 4020. Payroll Deductions for home loans. The  
5 Government of Guam is authorized with the consent of the employee  
6 which consent may be withdrawn at any time thereafter, to provide  
7 a payroll deduction for the making of mortgage payments by Govern-  
8 ment of Guam employees on home or appliance loans obtained by said  
9 employees wherein the Small Business Administration of the United  
10 States is mortgagee."

11 Section 2. Section 4018 of the Government Code of Guam, as enacted by  
12 Public Law 130, Sixth Guam Legislature, is hereby renumbered Section 4019.
