AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 122 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE "ORDER OF CHAMORRI".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 122 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

> "Section 122. Order of Chamorri. There is hereby established the 'Ancient Order of Chamorri' to consist of those men and women not native to the territory of Guam who shall have contributed substantially to the betterment of the people of Guam, or who shall have demonstrated real and sympathetic interest in the people of Guam, its history, cultures, traditions, and problems. Nembership in the Order shall entitle each recipient to all the courtesies of the Government of Guam, and a suitably inscribed Certificate of Membership in both English and Chamorro to be signed by the Governor of Guam and attested to by the Speaker of the Guam Legislature, which two officials of the Government of Guam shall have the responsibility of choosing the members of the Order."
