AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER 13 TO TITLE XII,  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATING TO  
APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Chapter 13, Title XII, Government Code of  
3 Guam, is hereby enacted to read as follows:

4 "CHAPTER 13

5 Apprenticeship

6 Section 11950. Committee. There is hereby established  
7 an Apprenticeship Development Committee which shall consider  
8 problems of developing local skills in the various crafts and  
9 trades, and developing a program of apprenticeship training  
10 and apprenticeship standards in accord with standards esta-  
11 blished by, and acceptable for registration with, the Bureau  
12 of Apprenticeship and Training, United States Department of  
13 Labor.

14 Section 11951. Same: Composition. The Committee shall  
15 be composed of three members of the Guam Contractor's  
16 Association, three members of the general business community,  
17 three members of the general public of Guam, one member of  
18 the Department of Education and one member of the Department  
19 of Labor and Personnel. The members of the Committee shall  
20 be appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall be designated  
21 as Chairman.



1                   Section 11952. Rules and Regulations. The Committee  
2                   may prepare such rules and regulations as may be necessary  
3                   or desirable for the implementation of this Chapter which  
4                   shall be subject to approval and promulgation by Executive  
5                   Order of the Governor.

6                   Section 11953. Fund. There is hereby established a  
7                   special Apprenticeship Fund to account for necessary program  
8                   expenditures, and to receive and account for moneys received  
9                   from any source for purposes of the program. The Governor  
10                  is authorized to transfer such amounts as may be required  
11                  for instituting and conducting the program from operating  
12                  appropriations of the Department of Education."

13                  Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
