Committee on Rules, by request of the Governor in accordance with Section 6(b) of the Organic Act of Guam.

AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER 13 TO TITLE XII. GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATING TO APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Chapter 13, Title XII, Government Code of Guam, is hereby enacted to read as follows:

"CHAPTER 13

Apprenticeship

Section 11950. Committee. There is hereby established an Apprenticeship Development Committee which shall consider problems of developing local skills in the various crafts and trades, and developing a program of apprenticeship training and apprenticeship standards in accord with standards established by, and acceptable for registration with, the Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training, United States Department of Labor.

Section 11951. Same: Composition. The Committee shall be composed of three members of the Guam Contractor's Association, three members of the general business community, three members of the general public of Guam, one member of the Department of Education and one member of the Department of Labor and Personnel. The members of the Committee shall be appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall be designated as Chairman.

Section 11952. Eules and Regulations. The Committee may prepare such rules and regulations as may be necessary or desirable for the implementation of this Chapter which shall be subject to approval and promulgation by Executive Order of the Governor.

Section 11953. Fund. There is hereby established a special Apprenticeship Fund to account for necessary program expenditures, and to receive and account for moneys received from any source for purposes of the program. The Governor is authorized to transfer such amounts as may be required for instituting and conducting the program from operating appropriations of the Department of Education."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
