AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4233 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN TO PROVIDE COVERAGE OF MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE IN THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAN RETIREMENT FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 4233 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4233. Coverage of members of the Legislature.

- (a) Except as may be otherwise expressly provided in this section, the provisions of this chapter shall apply to any person who has served as a member of the Legislature, or who shall hereafter serve as such a member and any such person shall be entitled to receive an annuity calculated in accordance with Section 4211 of this title and based upon his years of credited service as hereinafter provided.
- (b) For the purposes of this section and of Section
  4211 of this title, service as a member of the Legislature
  during a regular session in any one calendar year shall be
  deemed a full year of service as a member of the Legislature.
- (c) Any person who has served as a member of the Legislature or who shall hereafter serve as such a member shall be entitled to receive credit as prior service for all service rendered as a member of the Legislature or in any other department, division, or agency of the government of Guam; provided, that in order to obtain credit for such prior service as a member of the Legislature, a person shall pay within five years after January I, 1964, an amount equal to the hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) for each year of

service as masker of the Legislature during the period 1951 to 1964.

- of the Legislature on January 1, 1964 or who shall thereafter become such a member the annual overage compensation of such person for the purposes of this chapter shall be considered as Wine Thomsand Eight Hundred Eighty Dallars (\$9,880.00) and the assumt of contribution required of such person for the purposes of Section 4216 of this title shall be Three Hundred tellars (\$300.00) annually.
- (e) No provisions of this chapter or any other act relating to automatic separation from the service shall be applicable to any neater of the tegislature.
- (f) As used in this section, the term 'Legislature' scens the Guara Legislature created by the Organic Act of Guara, (64 Stat. 395).
- (g) Noted that ending any other provisions of this section, the provisions of this chapter shall not apply to any ecases of the regislature until he gives notice in writing, while serving as a member of the regislature, to the Board of his desire to come within the purview of this chapter. (h) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, the provisions hereof shall not apply to any member of the Legislature who, while serving therein, is already receiving benefits under this chapter as a result of service in any other department, division, or agency of the Government of Guam."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
