AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 21105 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE  
OF GUAM TO MAKE REFUSING TO PAY TAXI FARE A MISDEMEANOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 21105 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam  
to read as follows:

"Section 21105. Refusal to Pay Fare, Misdemeanor:

Penalty. Every person who wilfully refuses to pay the legal  
taxi rate charged by a licensed taxi driver for taxi services  
furnished by such driver to such person, shall, upon conviction,  
be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more  
than five hundred (500) dollars or by imprisonment of not  
more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
