AN ACT TO LIMIT THE LIABILITY TO GUESTS IN MOTOR VEHICLES BY ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 8 TO TITLE KKIV OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam,
That the following new Chapter 8 is added to Title EXIV of the Government
Code of Guam:

"CHAPTER 8

"LIABILITY TO 'GUESTS'

"Section 23550. Mability to 'guests'. No person riding in or occupying a wehicle owned by him and driven by another person with his permission and no person who as a guest accepts a ride in any vehicle upon a highway without giving compensation for such ride, nor any other person, has any right of action for civil damages against the driver of the vehicle or against any other person legally liable for the conduct of the driver on account of personal injury to or the death of the owner or guest during the ride, unless the plaintiff in any such action establishes that the injury or death proximately resulted from the intoxication or willful misconduct of the driver."
