



**CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR**

AN ACT REPEALING AND ADDING A NEW SECTION 15007  
AND AMENDING SECTION 2654 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE  
OF GUAM RELATIVE TO FILLING VACANCIES IN THE  
OFFICE OF CHIEF COMMISSIONER, COMMISSIONER, AND  
ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 15007 of Chapter 1, Title XVI, Govern-  
ment Code of Guam, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. A new Section 15007 is hereby added to Chapter  
1, Title XVI, Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 15007. Vacancies. Vacancies in the Offices of  
Chief Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner shall be filled by appoint-  
ment by the Governor of Guam by and with the advice and consent of the Guam  
Legislature, and such appointees shall serve during the unexpired portions  
of the terms for which their predecessors were appointed or elected.


"If, by reason of death, resignation, removal from office,  
inability, or failure to qualify, there is a vacancy in the office of  
Commissioner of a Municipality or Village for which there is an Assistant  
Commissioner, then the Assistant Commissioner shall, upon his resignation  
as Assistant Commissioner, act as Commissioner. A vacancy in the office  
of Commissioner of a Municipality or Village for which there is no Assistant  
Commissioner shall be filled for the unexpired term at a special election  
to be called by the Governor in accordance with the special election pro-  
visions set forth in Chapter 13, Title III, of the Government Code.

Section 3. Section 2654 is amended to read as follows:


"Section 2654. Election for filling vacancies for  
municipalities. The Governor of Guam shall call a special election at any  
time prior to eight months before the date of the next ensuing regularly  
scheduled election to fill a vacancy in any municipality required by law  
to be filled at a special election."

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4003, GOVERNMENT CODE OF  
GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE PERSONNEL  
BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 4003, Government Code of Guam, is hereby  
amended to read as follows:

"Section 4003. Personnel Board. The Governor is authorized  
to appoint, by and with the advice and consent of the Guam  
Legislature, a Personnel Board consisting of five members whose  
terms of office shall be three years. Vacancies occurring in the  
membership of the Board prior to the expiration of a term shall be  
filled by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Guam Legislature, for the unexpired portion of the term. Members  
shall not be employees of the government of Guam nor hold any  
elective office during their term on said Personnel Board and  
they shall serve without compensation except that they may be re-  
imbursed for necessary travel expenses. The Governor shall desig-  
nate one of the members of the Board as chairman and the Board  
shall meet not less frequently than bimonthly."
