



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS  
FOR THE OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH  
OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL  
YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1965, AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated  
from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to supplement prior  
appropriations for operation of the Executive Branch of the Government of  
Guam, for fiscal year ending June 30, 1965:
