



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO CREATE GREATER AUTONOMY FOR THE
GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL IN THE AREAS OF
EMPLOYMENT AND PROCUREMENT BY ADDING NEW
SECTIONS 4000.1, 6600.2 AND 49006 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, BY AMENDING SEC-
TION 6600.1, OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF
GUAM, AND BY REPEALING SECTIONS 6600.2
AND 49006 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

That the following new Section 4000.1 is added to the
Government Code of Guam:

"Section 4000.1. Inapplicability. Sections 4001, 4004,
4005, 4006, 4006.1, 4007, 4009, 4010, 4012, 4110.3, 4111(b), 4111(c),
and 4111(d) of this Code and the personnel rules of the Personnel Board
shall not apply to appointment, employment, promotion, or other personnel
policies for the Guam Memorial Hospital."

Section 2. Section 6600.1 of the Government Code of Guam
is amended to read as follows:

"Section 6600.1. Central procurement and warehousing.
The procurement and warehousing of all supplies for the government of
Guam other than for the Guam Memorial Hospital shall be a function of the
Department of Finance, in accordance with such terms, conditions, and
procedures as shall be prescribed by the Governor by Executive Order,
including such exceptions as may be deemed in the interest of the govern-
ment.

Section 3. Section 6600.2 of the Government Code of Guam is repealed in its entirety and substituted therefor is a new Section 6600.2 as follows:

"Section 6600.2. GHI Procurement and Warehousing. The procurement and warehousing of all supplies for the Guam Memorial Hospital shall be a function of the Guam Memorial Hospital, in accordance with such terms, conditions, and procedures as shall be prescribed by the Governor by Executive Order, including such exceptions as may be deemed in the interest of the government."

Section 4. Section 49006 of the Government Code of Guam is repealed in its entirety and substituted therefor is a new Section 49006 as follows:

"Section 49006. Personnel. (a) Appointment, employment, promotion, and other personnel policies for the Guam Memorial Hospital shall be established by the Administrator of the Guam Memorial Hospital with the approval of the Board.

"(b) Sections 4001, 4004, 4005, 4006, 4006.1, 4007, 4009, 4010, 4012, 4110.3, 4111(b), 4111(c), and 4111(d) of this Code and the personnel rules of the Personnel Board shall not apply to appointment, employment, promotion, or other personnel policies for the Guam Memorial Hospital."
