

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM,

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from  
3 any available sums in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund,  
4 for the purposes set forth herein:

- 5 (a) Grading, paving and fencing of 1,000 square feet  
6 area near Vehicle Inspection Station for impounded  
7 vehicles. \$ 4,000
- 8 (b) Construction of additional Administration

- 10 (c) Purchase of Executive Branch automotive  
11 equipment for replacement. 221,800
- 12 (d) Highway and pavement construction. 140,000
- 13 (e) Installation of fuel tanks and hoists at  
14 Public Works yard. 5,000
- 15 (f) Implementation of Uniform Traffic sign  
16 program. 5,000
- 17 (g) Construction of Sister's Quarters. 225,000
- 18 (h) Construction of Storage building for  
19 medical equipment. 20,000
- 20 (i) Continuation of the improvement and repair of  
21 Agana Boat Basin. 16,000
- 22 (j) Construction of new Farmers Market. 50,000
- 23 (k) Purchase and install wholesale market re-  
24 frigeration facilities. 5,000
- 25 (l) Installation of septic tank at Department of  
26 Agriculture. \$ 650

- 1 (m) Construction of prefabricated green house \$ 16,000
- 2 (n) Construction of additional sidewalk on

10 Section 2. At least 75% of all sums spent on purchases  
 11 made pursuant to any item of this Act shall be spent on purchases  
 12 of products and materials produced or manufactured in the United  
 13 States of America.

14 Section 3. Appropriations made by this Act shall take  
 15 effect and be available as of July 1, 1965.
