


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR NECESSARY  
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM,

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from  
any available sums in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund,  
for the purposes set forth herein:
