AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 901 OF THE PROBATE CODE OF CUAM RELATIVE TO THE COMMISSIONS OF EXECUTORS AND ADMINISTRA-TORS OF DECEDENTS' ESTATES.

Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That Section 901 of the Probate Code of Guam is amended to read as follows:

"Section 901. Commissions. The executor, when no compensation is provided by the will or he renounces all claim thereto, or the administrator, shall receive commissions upon the amount of estate accounted for by him, as follows: For the first \$1000, at the rate of 7 per cent; for the mext \$9000, at the rate of 4 per cent; for the next \$40,000, at the rate of 3 per cent; for the mext \$100,000, at the rate of 2 per cent; for the next \$350,000, at the rate of 1½ per cent; and for all above \$500,000, at the rate of 1 per cent. If there are two or more executors or administrators, the compensation shall be apportioned among them by the court according to the services actually rendered by each."
