AN ACT ADDING A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH (g) TO SECTION 23137 OF
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO RIGHT TURNS BY
OPERATORS STOPPED AT RED LIGHT SIGNALS.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That the
2 following new Subparagraph (g) is added to Section 23137 of the Government
3 Code of Guam:

4 "(g) The operator of a vehicle which is stopped at the entrance
5 of an intersection in obedience to a red light signal may make a right turn
6 but shall yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and other traffic proceeding
7 as directed by the signal at said intersection, except that the Director of
8 Public Safety may, by regulation, prohibit any such right turn against a
9 red light signal at any intersection, which regulation shall be effective
10 when a sign is erected at such intersection giving notice thereof."
