AN ACT ADDING A NEW SUBPARAGRAPH (g) TO SECTION 23137 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN RELATIVE TO RIGHT TURNS BY OPERATORS STOPPED AT RED LIGHT SIGNALS.

Be it enacted by the Feople of the territory of Guam. That the following new Subparagraph (g) is added to Section 23137 of the Government Code of Guam:

"(g) The operator of a vehicle which is stopped at the entrance of an intersection in obedience to a red light signal may make a right turn but shall yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and other traffic proceeding as directed by the signal at said intersection, except that the Director of Public Safety may, by regulation, prohibit any such right turn against a red light signal at any intersection, which regulation shall be effective when a sign is erected at such intersection giving notice thereof."
