Introduced by Alberto T. Lamorena

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 11838 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM
RELATIVE TO THE DEFINITION OF "NONRESIDENT STUDENT" OF THE
COLLEGE OF GUAM.

Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That Section
11838 of the Government Code of Guam is amended to read as follows:

"Section 11838. "Nonresident student" defined. "Nonresident student"
means any person who has not been a bona fide resident of the territory of Guam
for more than one year immediately preceding the opening day of a semester
during which he proposes to attend the College. Every alien student who has
not been admitted for permanent residence in accordance with the United States
Immigration and Naturalization Service, is deemed to be a nonresident student."
