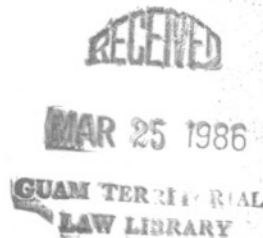

**AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23318 (a), CHAPTER 3,
TITLE XXIV, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO DISPLAY OF REGISTRATION.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

**Section 1. Section 23318 (a), Government Code of Guam, is hereby
amended to read as follows:**

**"(a) Every owner upon receipt of a registration card
shall write his signature thereon with pen and ink in the space
provided and shall place and thereafter maintain the same or
a facsimile copy thereof in the registered vehicle."**
