AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Fifty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$59,500), is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to supplement the government's contribution to the Retirement Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965.

Section 2. The sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000), is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the operation of the Guam Air Terminal for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966.

Sixty Six Thousand Dollars (\$66,000)

Section 3. The sum of One Hundred One Thousand Dollars (\$101,000), is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the Scholarship and Student Loan Fund.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$22,000), for renovation of government housing, and the sum of Fifty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$56,500), for the purchase of furniture and equipment for government housing.

Section 5. The sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000), is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for portraits of former Governors Joseph Flores and William Daniel.

Section 6. The appropriations made by Sections three through five of this

Act shall remain in full force and effect until expended for the purpose for which made,
or until the purpose is accomplished.
