AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR GOVERNMENT  
OPERATIONS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

1                   Section 1. The sum of Fifty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$59,500),  
2  
3 is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the  
4 General Fund to supplement the government's contribution to the Retirement Fund for  
5 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965.

6                   Section 2. The sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000), is hereby  
7 appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General  
8 Fund for the operation of the Guam Air Terminal for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
9 1966.

10                   Section 3. The sum of ~~One Hundred One Thousand Dollars (\$101,000)~~ <sup>Sixty Six Thousand Dollars (\$66,000)</sup> is  
11 hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the  
12 General Fund for the Scholarship and Student Loan Fund.

13                   Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the  
14 Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-Two Thousand Dollars  
15 (\$22,000), for renovation of government housing, and the sum of Fifty-Six Thousand  
16 Five Hundred Dollars (\$56,500), for the purchase of furniture and equipment for  
17 government housing.

18                   Section 5. The sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000), is hereby appro-  
19 priated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund  
20 for portraits of former Governors Joseph Flores and William Daniel.

21                   Section 6. The appropriations made by Sections three through five of this  
22 Act shall remain in full force and effect until expended for the purpose for which made,  
23 or until the purpose is accomplished.
