AN ACT ELIMINATING THE POLITICAL PARTY BOX FROM BALLOTS BY AMENDING SECTIONS 2256, 2308, and 2520 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 That Section 2256 of the Government Code of Guam is amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 2256. Space for marking ballot. Immediately to the right of the name
4 of each nominee, or to the right of the word 'Incumbent,' as the case may be, shall be
5 placed a square of sufficient size for the marking of a cross or a check mark therein.
6 A cross or check mark placed within the square immediately after the name of a nominee
7 shall be counted as a vote for the nominee whose name precedes such square."

8 Section 2. Section 2308 of the Government Code of Guam is amended to read as
9 follows:

10 "Section 2308. Indicating vote. In voting, the voter shall place a cross or a
11 check mark in the voting square after the name of any nominee for whom he intends to vote
12 or shall vote for a candidate or person whose name is not printed on the ballot by writing
13 a name for that office in the blank space left therefor."

14 Section 3. Section 2520. of the Government Code of Guam is amended to read as
15 follows:

16 "Section 2520. Only invalid portion rejected. If a voter indicates either:
17 (a) by placing his marks in the voting squares after the names of any candidates, or
18 (b) by writing the names of persons for an office in the blank spaces, or
19 (c) by combination of both, the choice of more than there are candidates to be elected
20 or certified for any office, or if for any reason it is impossible to determine his
21 choice for any office, his ballot shall not be counted for that office, but the
22 rest of his ballot, if properly marked, shall be counted.
