AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 22001 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM  
RELATIVE TO THE QUALIFICATIONS OF NOTARIES PUBLIC.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That Section 22001  
2 of the Government Code of Guam is amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 22001. Same: Qualifications. Every person appointed as notary  
4 public must be, at the time of appointment, a citizen of the United States, domiciled  
5 in Guam for at least 1 year immediately preceding the date of his appointment, twenty-  
6 one years of age, and of a good moral character."
