


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 13600 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO EXTEND THE PERIOD FOR LAND PERMIT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM.

2 Section 1, Section 13600 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 13600. Use Permits. (a) The Director with the approval
5 of the Governor is authorized to grant permits for the use of any suitable govern-
6 ment real property, not otherwise occupied or in use, for agricultural purposes,
7 including grazing.

8 (b) Such permits shall be granted for a period not exceeding twenty
9 (20) years.

10 (c) No person shall use or occupy under any such permit more than
11 fifty hectares for grazing or more than ten hectares for any other agricultural
12 purpose.

13 (d) The Department shall collect a reasonable charge from each
14 permit-holder based upon the fair market value of the land and the use made
15 thereof.

16 (e) The form of such permits shall be prescribed by the Attorney
17 General.

18 (f) The Director, with the approval of the Governor, shall make
19 such reasonable rules, not inconsistent with the foregoing provisions of this

1 section, governing the qualifications for, applications for an issuance of such
2 permits, the terms and conditions thereof, the charges to be collected therefor,
3 supervision of operations thereunder, and enforcement of the terms thereof as
4 may be necessary or desirable to the efficient administration of the program and
5 in the public interest."
