AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AN ACCELERATED
EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM FOR VOLUNTEERS REJECTED BY THE
ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.

1 WHEREAS a number of our young men failed their recruitment test at the time
2 of induction into the Armed Forces of the United States, and

3 WHEREAS these young men could become great assets to Guam and should be given
4 accelerated educational training to qualify them for service in the Armed Forces of the
5 United States, now, therefore,

6 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That there is hereby
7 appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
8 the sum of ^{Five Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$5,700)} ~~Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500)~~ for the Governor's Committee on ^{15/15/65}
9 Children and Youth to be used exclusively for an Accelerated Educational Program to
10 qualify young men and women of Guam for service in the Armed Forces of the United States.
