AN ACT AMENDING SUBPARAGRAPH (c) OF SECTION
9620.11 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM
RELATIVE TO THE DESTRUCTION OF RABID DOGS.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That subparagraph
2 (c) of Section 9620.11 of the Government Code of Guam is amended to read as follows:
3 "(c) Any dog found to have clinical symptoms of rabies
4 shall be destroyed and the brain thereof shall be examined
5 as soon as possible for negri bodies by both the microscopic
6 and fluorescent anti-body methods."
