AN ACT ADDING A NEW SECTION 1000,5 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF LEGISLATIVE COMPENSATION AND ALLOWANCES.

Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That the following new Section 1000,5 is added to the Government Code of Guam:

"Section 1000,5. Legislative compensation and allowances. Commencing as of 1 January 1966 the compensation of each member of the Guam Legislature shall be paid in equal monthly installments at the rate of \$4,500 per annum; the compensation of the Speaker of the Guam Legislature shall be paid in equal monthly installments at the rate of \$5,000 per annum; and there also shall be paid to each member, including the Speaker of the Guam Legislature an allowance of \$25 for each day that the Legislature is in regular or special session. Such compensation and allowance shall be paid out of funds to be appropriated by the Guam Legislature."

Section 2. This Act is based upon the recommendation of the Guam Legislative Salary Commission.
