AN ACT MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
OPERATION OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT  
OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1966.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated, from  
any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, to  
supplement prior appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966.

a. Department of Public Works	\$ 37,000
b. Department of Public Health and Welfare	57,162
c. Department of Education	15,000
d. College of Guam	65,000
e. Department of Land Management	8,266
f. Travel and Transportation	51,000
g. Retirement	185,000

Section 2. The Governor with the prior approval of the  
Committee on Rules may transfer not to exceed ten per cent (10%) of any  
appropriation of Section 1, above, to any other item or items of the appro-  
priation of Section 1, but no item of appropriation shall be increased more  
than ten percentum as a result of such transfer. Whenever, in order to  
promote efficiency and economy of operation in the Executive Branch, the  
Governor provides for the transfer of responsibility for the administration  
of any function or program from one department, agency, or office of the  
government to another, he may also with the prior approval of the Committee  
on Rules of the Guam Legislature direct the transfer of appropriations  
allocated to such function or program notwithstanding any limitations as to  
amount. A quarterly statement of any transfers made pursuant to this section  
shall be submitted to the Legislature.
