


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 13525 OF THE GOVERNMENT  
CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE EXCHANGE OF PRIVATE  
LAND IN AGANA FOR GOVERNMENT LAND.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That  
2 Section 13525 of the Government Code of Guam is amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 13525. Exchange of Land in Lieu of Cash Payment.

4 (a) Whenever privately owned lands are required by the govern-  
5 ment of Guam, the owner of such land may apply to the Director of Land  
6 Management for government-owned lands to be exchanged, totally or partially  
7 in lieu of cash payment, for the lands required by the Government. If such  
8 government-owned land is not needed for public purposes, the Director of  
9 Land Management, with the approval of the Governor, may make such exchange  
10 of property and cash as will equalize the respective values of such property.

11 "(b) With the approval of the Governor and the owner thereof  
12 the Director of Land Management may exchange government-owned land not needed  
13 for a public purpose for privately owned land of equal value located within  
14 the City of Agana.

15 "(c) It shall be the duty of the Director of Land Management  
16 to formulate such rules, regulations and procedures as are now necessary to  
17 effectuate the aims and intent of this section."
