AN ACT ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION (c) TO SECTION 1016 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE TURN-OVER OF PRO-PERTY, RECORDS, AND FILES FROM AN OUTGOING LEGISLATURE TO AN INCOMING LEGISLATURE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That a new Sub-Section (c) be added to Title II, Ghapter 1, Section 1016 of the Government Code of Guam, as follows:

"(c) Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, and for an orderly transition from one Legislature to another, it shall be the duty and obligation of all attaches and employees of the Legislature, to remain at their posts and perform their duties until otherwise relieved or until their services are terminated by an incoming Legislature. The Chairman of the Rules Committee of an outgoing Legislature, within ten (10) days following the declaration of results and issuance of certificates of election under the Election Law, shall account for and effect the orderly turn-over of legislative keys and other property, records, and files to the Legislator designated for the purpose by the majority of the incoming Legislators."
