


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT REPEALING SUBPARAGRAPH (12) OF SECTION  
23132 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND  
ADDING A NEW SECTION 23132.3 TO THE GOVERNMENT  
CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE PARKING OF MOTOR  
VEHICLES.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That Sub-  
2 paragraph (12) of Section 23132 of the Government Code of Guam is repealed.

3 Section 2. The following new Section 23132.3 is added to the  
4 Government Code of Guam:

5 "Section 23132.3. Parking signs. The Director of Public  
6 Safety may place signs prohibiting or restricting the stopping,  
7 standing, or parking of vehicles on any highway in Guam where  
8 in his opinion such stopping, standing, or parking is dangerous  
9 to those using the highway or where the stopping, standing, or  
10 parking may unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic  
11 thereon or the access of the public to limited parking near office  
12 or commercial buildings. Such signs shall be official signs and  
13 no person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle in violation of  
14 the restrictions stated on such signs."
