AN ACT REPEALING SUBPARAGRAPH (12) OF SECTION 23132 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM AND ACDING A NEW SECTION 23132.3 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Feople of the territory of Guam, That Subparagraph (12) of Section 23132 of the Government Code of Guam is repealed.

Section 2. The following new Section 23132.3 is added to the Government Code of Guam:

"Section 23132.3. Parking signs. The Director of Public
Safety may place signs prohibiting or restricting the stopping,
standing, or parking of vehicles on any highway in Guam where
in his opinion such stopping, standing, or parking is dangerous
to those using the highway or where the stopping, standing, or
parking may unduly interfere with the free movement of traffic
thereon or the access of the public to limited parking near office
or commercial buildings. Such signs shall be official signs and
no person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle in violation of
the restrictions stated on such signs."
