AN ACT ADDING A NEW SECTION 396a TO THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF POWER BOATS.

Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That the following new Section 396a is added to the Penal Code of Guam:

"Section 396a. Power boats, regulations regarding. Every owner, operator, or person in command of any power boat is guilty of a misdemeanor who operates it or permit it to be operated at a speed in excess of five nautical miles per hour in any portion of the following areas:

(a) Within 100 feet of any person (other than a person engaged in the sport of water skiing) who is engaged in the act of bathing.

(b) Within 200 feet of any:

(1) Beach frequented by bathers.

(2) Swimming float, diving platform, or life line.

(3) Way or landing float to which boats are made fast which is used for the embarkation or discharge of passengers.

The provisions of this Section shall apply to all waters which are in fact navigable regardless of whether they are declared navigable by this Code or any other provision of law."
