

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 14, TITLE XII OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM SO AS TO INCREASE THE
MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION ON CHAMORRO LAN-
GUAGE FROM FIVE (5) MEMBERS TO NINE (9) MEMBERS.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam, That
2 Section 11975 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 11975. Creation of commission. There is hereby
5 established the "Commission on the Chamorro Language," to consist of Nine
6 (9) members, all citizens of the United States and residents of Guam who
7 must be conversant in the Chamorro language and who shall be appointed by
8 the Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislature for a term of
9 three (3) years. Three of whom shall serve for one year, three for two
10 years and three for three years, provided however that the five members
11 heretofore appointed shall serve the full term of their present appoint-
12 ments." The Governor shall appoint one among 9 members its chairman of
13 the commission.
