

Introduced by <u>Committee on Rules by</u> request of the Governor

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 345 TO THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM PROHIBITING THE LITTER OF HIGHWAYS, PARKS, AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES.

Be it enacted by the people of the territory of Guam, That a new Section 345 is hereby added to the Penal Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 345. Proscription of Litter in Public Places.

(a) No person shall place, dispose, throw, or permit to be deposited or scattered, any waste, refuse, litter, or foreign substance in or upon any highway, street or other public passageway, or upon any beach, or public park, where receptacles have been provided therefor and signs posted by the government of Guam.

(b) Violation of this section shall be a misdemeanor punished by a fine not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)."
